## 10 Questions to Ask Before Adapting Your Novel into a Screenplay

- 1. Do you already have a fanbase for your current novel?
- 2. Do you want to gain more exposure for your library of books?
- 3. Is your book the right size for adapting? It can be a struggle to condense a longer book into one two-hour movie.
- 4. Are you willing to learn how to format your screenplay correctly?
- 5. Are you willing to invest money into a screenwriting software tool?
- 6. Does the story seem like it would make a good film? In other words, will audiences be able to follow the story visually or is it better told in text form?
- 7. Are you willing and able to kill your darlings (i.e. combine or delete characters)?
- 8. Are you willing to write a screenplay that may not be identical to your novel?
- 9. Have you studied at least 10 other screenplays and watched the accompanying movie to get a feel for how the scripted book played out on the screen?
- 10. Are you willing to re-read your script multiple times all the way through over the course of several months?
