Here are 20 ideas to get you started on Instagram.

- 1. Show images of your book in various places, such as a desk, a coffee table, outdoors, *etc.*
- 2. Pull quotes from your book and turn them into images.
- 3. Show a photo of your actual workspace.
- Share screenshots of your book reviews.
- 5. Highlight fan artwork of your book or its characters.
- 6. Show you at work (not just your workspace).
- 7. Show a behind the scenes look at your book tour or signing.
- 8. Create a graphic for an upcoming sale or book event.
- 9. Create quote graphics from other books/ authors that you admire.
- 10. Share writing tips.
- 11. Show a throwback of younger you.
- 12. Host a Q&A session where you share a fan's question as a graphic and leave the answer in the caption.
- 13. Create stories where you share videos of your life.
- 14. Highlight a follower.
- 15. Recommend a book.
- 16. Create a reading challenge for your followers.
- 17. In your <u>Instagram story</u>, ask a question for your followers to answer.
