Here is a list of questions to ask your beta readers.

- 1. How is the pacing in the introductory chapter? Did it move too slow or too fast?
- 2. Are you able to get a good sense of setting?
- 3. Is the setting consistent?
- 4. Do you understand the motivation of each character?
- 5. Are the characters believable?
- 6. Are there too many characters?
- 7. If you had to remove a character, who would you choose and why?
- 8. Is the protagonist relatable? If yes, how? If not, why?
- 9. Is the antagonist in any way sympathetic?
- 10. Are you confused by the characters' names?
- 11. How do you feel about the characters?
- 12. Does the dialogue between characters slow down any of the scenes? If yes, when?
- 13. Are you ever confused or frustrated by the plot? If so, when?
- 14. Do you get bored while reading the story? If so, when?
- 15. Are there any discrepancies in the story? Can you name any that you noticed?
- 16. Do you enjoy the ending or do you feel like it was incomplete? If incomplete, what is missing for you?
- 17. Were you able to predict the ending before it happened? If yes, when?
- 18. How would you describe the plot to someone else?
- 19. Do you feel (angry, happy, sad, scared) at any point while reading? What emotion and when?
