Best Practices for Creating Your Own Book Cover

- □ Use legible font for the title of your book.
- Study other books and make note of what you like and don't like in each cover.
- □ Create a design that's similar in feel to others in your genre.
- Use colors thoughtfully. As a rule of thumb, use complementary color combinations (these are colors that are opposite each other on the color wheel).
- □ Use high quality stock.
- **□** Remember that less is more.
- Avoid using photos of real people, especially of their faces-- it takes away from the reader's imagination.
- □ Make sure that it looks good in a thumbnail.
- □ Trust your instincts.
